



MEETING CHILDREN'S NEEDS AT PLAYGROUP

- Let children know what is happening at playgroup
- Comply with health and hygiene policies
- Be aware of children's whereabouts at all times
- Anticipate children's needs and responding appropriately
- Comfort distressed children quickly and sensitively
- Provide assistance when children are having difficulty communicating with each other
- Balance supervising and Facilitation of children's play
- Encourage children to do what they are able to do for themselves
- Assist although never do a craft activity for a child
- Do not insist that children take part in all table activities
- Acknowledge a child's creative art process rather than insisting on a finished end product
- Share mat time experience with children by joining in with the activities
- Share children's home language and culture
